



# Instructions for Nominating a Potential Life Member

Full details of the process for nominating a member for life membership and the privileges it provided may be found in clause 7 of the constitution. The requirements for a valid nomination are summarised as below.

The nominee for life membership must satisfy the following

1. Currently a member of the club.
2. Has been a member of the club for a minimum of seven years (not necessarily continuous).
3. Has made a significant contribution to the club (need not have held a position on the management committee). Note, merely being a member for many years is not sufficient.

The person nominating a potential life member must complete the form as follows:

1. The form should be completed legibly.
2. The form must be signed and dated by the member making the nomination.
3. The nomination must be supported by two members in addition to the member making the nomination. The supporting members must also sign and date the form.
4. The completed form must be received by the secretary not later than 21 January immediately preceding the annual general meeting at which the vote for life membership is to take place.
5. In the space provided and/or with attached documentation the nominating member should state why they believe the member being nominated for life membership is worthy of the honour. Any activities in furtherance of the aims whether to the benefit of the club as a whole or on a more individual level may be included.
6. If attachments are included in the nomination, please write the number of additional pages attached on the form. If there are no attachments please write 0 in the space provided.
